- Photocopy your up to date first aid /cpr certificate, a hunter safety card or a Wildlife Resource Card, your recreational boating card and send it along with a check for \$200.00 made out to "The Nova Scotia Guides Association" to Vinal Smith RR#1 Hunts Point N.S.. B0T 1G0. I will send you a receipt in return mail If needed.
