Saturday, February 19th - 9:00AM until 9:00 PM

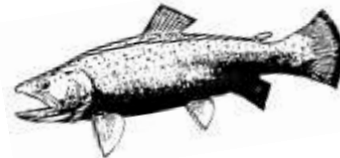
Sunday, February 20th - 8:00 AM until 9:00 PM
