RULES AND REGULATIONS

To make your stay more enjoyable for yourself and others, are expected to follow campground rules. These terms are put in place to help ensure the safety and enjoyment of all users. Campers assume full responsibility for their visitors. Please make sure anyone visiting your site knows and understands what is allowed.

First Aid – The campground First Aid and/or medical emergency provider will be posted at the club house at the beginning of the season.

SPEED LIMIT: Maximum speed of 5 km/h is strictly enforced - No exceptions. If you're driving faster than you can walk, SLOW DOWN.

ATVs: Use of personal ATVs is prohibited in the campgrounds.

BEACH/SWIMMING: Beach and swimming areas are unsupervised. Use at your own risk. Parents/Guardians are responsible for their child's safety.

Swimming is at your own risk. No swimming after dark. No rough-housing permitted on the dock, raft or within the confines of any water area.

BICYCLES: All bicycle users must wear a helmet. Bicycles must be off the camp ground roads at dusk.

CAMP FIRES: Camp fires are only allowed in the fire pits provided at each camp site. Non-combustibles, such as cans and bottles, shall not be placed in fire pits/fireplaces. Please check with campground administrator regarding fire bans.

QUIET HOUR: Quiet hour is between 2:00AM – 7:00AM. Excessive noise should be kept at a minimum as to not disturb other campers.

CURFEW: Youth Curfew:

- a. Children 12 years old and under must be at their campsite by 9:30 PM
- b. Children 13-18 years old (inclusive) must be at their campsite by 11:00PM.

If off your campsite after these hours, child(ren) must be accompanied by a parent/legal guardian.

FIGHTING: Fighting, rowdy behavior, excessive noise or swearing will not be tolerated.

DAMAGES: Wilful damage of any sort will not be tolerated. Cutting and carving of standing trees, whether dead or not, is strictly prohibited.

EQUIPMENT: Transfer of picnic tables, firepits, or any established fixture from one campsite to another is prohibited.

FIREWORKS: Fireworks of any kind are strictly prohibited.

GARBAGE: Garbage bins are provided in the field, so please use them.

PETS: All dogs are to be on a leash in the confines of the campground. Poop and scoop applies at all times.
